#### PLACEMENT HIGHLIGHTS

In the month of January 23, ANGLO EASTERN SHIP MANAGEMENT PVT. LTD visited campus for placements on 10th Jan. The package offered is \$750 per month (after 1 year training) that will be increased to 1.5 Lakhs INR after next 6 months. During the Bluestar Placement Drive held on January 16th and 18th, three students from the B.Tech

(MAE) 2023 batch were selected and offered a package of approximately 6.25 Lacs per annum. On January 31st, a placement drive of SIBRAMA was held at the company's premises and nine students from the ECE (2023 batch) registered for it. The post offered by the company was IT Admin, with an initial package of 2.4 to 4 Lacs per annum.







## EXTERNAL RELATIONS AND COLLABORATIONS

The IEEE GBPEC Student Branch held an orientation program for B.Tech. students of the 2022-2026 batch on January 20, 2023, at the Campus Training and Placement Hall. 
